

# **MEMORANDUM** 14.02.2022

**BMX Racing**Special provisions for the 2022 season applying on 01.03.2022

The measure below is to cater for the introduction of the Under 23 categories to the UCI BMX Racing World Championships for the first time. As the category did not accumulate UCI Ranking points in 2021, there is no basis to allocate quota from a ranking. For this reason it is proposed that there be a flat quota across all National Federations of 3 riders for each of Men Under 23 and Women Under 23.

# PART IX – WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

### Article 9.2.047 sexies Qualification system world championships race

For Men Elite, Women Elite, Men Under 23, Women Under 23, Men Juniors and Women Juniors, the maximum number of riders for each category is determined on the basis of the UCI ranking by nation for each such category on 31<sup>st</sup> December of the preceding season.

### Amended for the 2022 season as:

For the Men Under 23 and Women Under 23, each National Federation has the right to enter up to 3 riders in each of the Men Under 23 and Women Under 23 categories.

All the measures set out in this document aim to ensure the continuity of the activities of the National Federations, the organisers, the teams and the riders in the best possible conditions of fairness and respect for the UCI Regulations while offering the necessary flexibility for the 2022 season due to covid-19 crisis.

## PART VI – BMX RACING

### Chapter IV Specific Rules for UCI BMX Racing World Challenge & Masters Events

Registration of Participants

- 6.4.006Pre-registration for the UCI BMX Racing World Challenge event is subject to the following restrictions:
  - a. Each national federation shall be permitted to register up to 16 riders in each Challenge level category which is scheduled for competition. The host organisation may register a greater number of riders in each limited category, with a maximum of 32 riders. b. Each national federation shall be permitted to register up to 16 riders in each Masters category.
  - c. The limits specified in 'a' and b' above exclude the riders ranked from 1 to 8 at the UCI BMX Racing World Challenge or Masters event of the previous year. These riders can be added on top of the riders selected according to the above criteria.

#### Amended for the 2022 season as:

Under c: The Main finalists from the 2019 UCI World Challenge & Masters event can be entered as well as the Nation quota.
